#### 1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Mildura Motorcycle Club, hereinafter called the PROMOTER, will conduct the King of the Murray Arenacross at Olympic Park Stadium on Saturday the 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2021.

#### 2. JURISDICTION

The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling Victoria (MV) and will be held in accordance with the General Competition Rules (GCR's) of Motorcycling Australia (MA), the by-laws of MV, these Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued by the stewards of the meeting.

**BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.**

#### 3. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted forthwith from current MA Senior National (SNA) and MA Junior National (JNA) competition licence holders. Current competition licence and current club membership card must be produced at sign in. One day licenses will be accepted at this event, please indicate on your entry form if you require a one-day license.

Only legible entries provided on the official entry form accompanied by the correct entry fee shall be accepted as valid entries.

Acceptance of entries for respective classes in excess of one full grid shall be at the discretion of the Promoter.

Priority shall be according to the order of entries received with correct fee payment.

Acceptance of late entries shall be at the Promoter's discretion.

#### 5. ADMISSION FEES

For the general public: \$25 for adults, \$10 for children and \$20 for pensioners. Do not include with your entry fee, admission fees can be paid for on the day.

#### 6. MEDICAL SERVICES

Mildura First Aid Services will be in attendance from the entirety of the event.

## 7. SIGN IN

Sign in for the abovementioned event will take place from 2.00pm to 4.00pm on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2021.

## 8. RIDERS BRIEFING

Attendance at the Riders Briefing is compulsory. The Riders Briefing will take place at 4.30pm Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2021.

## 9. TEMPORARY GUARDIAN

Riders under the age of 18, if not accompanied by parents, must have a guardianship form filled out prior to the event and presented at sign in. The guardian must be over 18 years and have ID.

## 10. MINIMUM ENTRIES

The promoter shall determine the number of entries constituting a class according to entries received. Grades may be combined with a higher or lower grade if insufficient entries are received to constitute a class. The club reserves the right to cancel / combine classes, re-distribute any awards and/or prize money and the depth of the places to be so awarded at its discretion.

## 11. CORNER DUTY

Flag marshals will be required for each round, please nominate a flag marshal on your entry form. Flag marshals will need to attend marshals briefing.

## 12. GRID POSITIONS

Will be selected for each heat by draw.

## 13. MACHINE EXAMINATION

All machines must comply with the 2021 GCR's

Scrutineering will commence at 4.00pm, all machines must be scrutineered prior to racing.

## 14. AWARDS

Prizes may be claimed at presentations held at the Mildura Motorcycle Club Clubrooms following the conclusion of the event.

Prizes shall be allocated (depending on Entry numbers) according to points in each class.

Senior Open Expert A Grade

First: \$2000, Second: \$500 plus UNIT gear bag full of riding gear, Third: \$250 plus UNIT gear bag full of gear, Fourth: \$125

Senior Open Expert B Grade

First: \$750, Second: \$375, Third: \$150, Fourth: \$100

Senior Open Class C Grade

First: \$500, Second: \$250, Third: \$100, Fourth: \$75

All Juniors Classes: First: Trophy, Second: Trophy, Third: Trophy

Transponder timing will be used throughout the meeting, MyLaps transponders will be supplied and fitted by the club if you do not have your own.

## 15. GST

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prize money. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 48.5% of prize money over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

## 16. CAMPING

Camping at the event is permitted.

## 17. CODE OF CONDUCT

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law – CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and will be enforced.

## 19. VENUE DESCRIPTION

The track comprises a start straight of 60 metres length and a circuit of 560 metres length. The track surface comprises sandy clay. The circuit comprises motocross style jumps, table tops, whoops, berms and flat runs.

A full canteen service will operate for the entirety of the event.

## GENERAL

1. **Noise:** Noise emissions must comply with rules as stated in the 2021 Manual of Motorcycle Sport.
2. **Numbers & Numberplates:** Must comply with the 2021 Manual of Motorcycle Sport.
3. **Change of Motorcycle:** A change of motorcycle may be permitted up to 15 minutes before the start of the race provided that the notice is in writing and handed to the secretary of the meeting and approval obtained by the stewards.
4. **Back Numbers:** All competitors must wear a corresponding and legible back number at all times when practicing or competing. Back numbers must be brought up to scrutineering for checking.
5. **Points Score:** As per 2021 Manual of Motorcycle Sport.
6. **Riding of Motorcycles:** The riding of any competing motorcycles in the pits or car park or camping area is not permitted. Inflicting riders will be brought before the stewards of the meeting. Any offender may be fined \$50.00, which must be paid before any further participation is permitted. No pit bikes or non - competing motorcycles are permitted to be ridden at any time at the venue.

7. **No Hassle Policy:** Any rider, entrant or person associated with a rider or entrant shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner in any dealings whatsoever, with any official of the meeting. A rider shall be responsible for his/her own conduct and that of any person with whom he/she is associated who abuses or threatens in any manner, either verbally or physically, any official. Penalties, which may be imposed by the stewards for breach, include reprimand or warning. Minimum \$50.00 fine or exclusion from the meeting.
8. **Abandonment:** In the event of the meeting being abandoned due to circumstances beyond the control of the promoters before racing commences, entry fees will be returned, less a fee per entry to cover administration costs. Once the competition has commenced only the stewards of the meeting have the authority to abandon the meeting and their decision shall be final. In such cases the stewards will rule on the results according to the circumstances.
9. **Bicycles:** Bicycles are not permitted in the pits or on the racing circuit. No Pit Bikes will be allowed anywhere at this complex.
10. **Animals:** Are not permitted into the grounds. Seeing Eye dogs are permitted.
11. **Motorcycles:** Are to be kept in the pit area at all times when not being used for competition. Unless permission to remove the motorcycle has been granted by the stewards of the meeting. Any motorcycle removed from the pit area without permission of the stewards, will be deemed to have withdrawn from the competition.
12. **Reservations:** The Stewards of the meeting reserve the right to alter, postpone or cancel all or part of the events program.
13. **Unauthorised:** Persons are prohibited from entering the track infield area. Such unauthorised persons will be removed from prohibited areas.
14. **IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL RIDERS/ENTRANTS/PARENTS/GUARDIANS: CAPITAL BENEFITS INSURANCE IS APPLICABLE TO ALL RIDERS WITH A CURRENT LICENCE.**  
It is conditional upon acceptance of this entry that it is fully understood by the rider/entrant/parent/guardian to arrange personal injury and ambulance transportation insurance cover in case you should require the same during the running of this competition.

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## CONTRACT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE KING OF THE MURRAY ARENACROSS

**IMPORTANT - THIS IS A CONTRACT. YOU MUST READ AND SIGN THIS CONTRACT BEFORE YOU PARTICIPATE.**

### Waiver Agreement

#### Recitals

- A. The Provider organises, and permits participants to participate in, the Recreational Activity in consideration for the Participant:
- If a rider, paying the Application Fee; and
  - If a volunteer official volunteering to officiate at the Recreational Activity;
  - If a member of the media, accepting the Provider's terms of media accreditation; and
- otherwise agreeing to be bound by the Provider's rules and directives governing the conduct of the Recreational Activity.
- B. This document is the contract between the Provider and the Participant with respect to the Participant's participation in the Recreational Activity.
- C. The purposes of this contract include to:
- exclude the liability of the Provider to the extent permissible by law to pay damages or any other form of compensation whether arising in tort contract or statute or at law or in equity for any personal injury or death of the Participant as a result of the participant's participation in the Recreational Activity; and
  - provide a warning of the risks of engaging in the Recreational Activity (as defined below).
- D. Participating in the Recreational Activity is dangerous. The risks include but are not limited to death, serious injury or illness due to:
- falling from your bike;
  - difficult terrain and obstacles;
  - hazardous and changeable track conditions;
  - rider error and/or lack of skill or care and/or dangerous or reckless behaviour on your part or the part of other participants;
  - undisclosed medical conditions;
  - decisions made or not made by organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings;
  - heat, cold, wet or other adverse weather conditions;
  - contact with vehicles, other participants or members of the public who may or may not be acting safely;
  - lack of access to medical, evacuation or search services; or
  - design of the track.

#### Operative parts

- In consideration for me (the Participant) paying or providing the consideration under clause A above to participate in the Recreational Activity, the Provider will permit me to participate in the Recreational Activity.
- I acknowledge that the Recreational Activity involves the risk of serious injury, physical harm or death. I warrant that I am aware that the Recreational Activity involves the risk of serious injury, physical harm or death.
- I also acknowledge that in signing this contract I have done so voluntarily and that no pressure or unfair tactics have been used to persuade me to sign this contract and that I have done so voluntarily in the knowledge that it is open to me not to sign the contract and for the Provider to refuse to permit me to participate in the Recreational Activity. I also warrant that I have been given sufficient opportunity to read this contract before signing it and that I have read it.
- I agree that the Provider and any directors or officers of the Provider and any person associated with organising the Recreational Activity shall not be liable to me or any other person for damages, compensation or loss, whether in tort, contract, under statute or at law or in equity or otherwise for any personal injury or death caused by, or in connection with, or arising out of, my participation in the Recreational Activity.

#### Definitions

**Application Fee** means the fee payable by the Participant (as a rider) to participate in the Recreational Activity.

**Participant** means the person signing this form and whose name appears next to Participant below.

**Provider** means those persons and entities listed in Annexure 1.

**Recreational Activity** means the event specified in Annexure 2.

#### Participant acknowledgements, consents and authorisations

- I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to only participate in the Recreational Activity if I am fit and able to do so.
- I acknowledge that I am responsible for all medical, hospital and ambulance expenses arising out of my participation in the Recreational Activity save for any benefits provided by MA's Personal Accident Policy.
- I authorise and consent to the Provider arranging any medical, hospital or ambulance services on my behalf if necessary arising out of my participation in the Recreational Activity.
- I authorise and consent to the Provider collecting and using my personal information for the purpose of administering the Recreational Activity and in accordance with the MA Privacy Policy.

3. I/We acknowledge that motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport and participating in the Event the Minor, takes and is exposed to certain risks and dangers including that:

- (a) the Minor may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
- (b) the Minor's machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
- (c) other competitors may ride dangerously or with lack of skill;
- (d) track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predicability;
- (e) the Organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of the Event are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time and/or events;
- (f) any policy of insurance of or in respect of the Minor's life or physical or mental health may be voided;
- (g) there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of the Minor if injured; and
- (h) entrants including the Minor have an obligation to themselves and to others to compete safely and within the rules of competition.

4. In consideration of the Organiser's accepting the Minor as an entrant in the Event I/We agree to indemnify the Guardian, the Organisers and each of them in the following manner:

- (a) that the Minor participates in the race meeting at my/our sole risk and responsibility;
- (b) that the Minor accepts the venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed;
- (c) that I/We indemnify and hold harmless the Organisers, their respective servants, agents or officials
